## From the Desk of Deacon Matt

It's one of the deepest mysteries of our faith: how three persons can be united in one divine being. On the solemnity of the Holy Trinity, we praise God the Father for sending the Son to save us from our sins and the Holy Spirit to remain with us always. The Holy Spirit draws us together as the body of Christ to receive the Son in the Eucharist and give glory to God the Father, in whose image we have been created. Let us praise and give thanks to Father, Son, and Holy Spirit for the infinite love and mercy we have received.

God's love for us comes across vividly in today's readings. God promises Moses to be merciful, gracious, and rich in kindness. Paul tells the Corinthians that the God of love and peace will be with them as they treat each other with love and live in peace. John points out that Christ's sacrifice on the cross is a vivid sign of God's great love for us. We are being challenged to not only listen to God's word with grateful hearts, but to live our lives worthy of the Sacrifice He made for us.

We can be merciful, gracious, slow to anger, kind, faithful, loving, and generous. The qualities that God puts first and foremost as godlike are qualities we can have—and use—as well. When we forgive and bear with one another, act kindly, give of ourselves, and love each other, we are acting as God self-identifies.

My sisters and brothers, if we do this, and I believe we can, and will, then we Live to Give the Gospel, Glorify the Lord, and Become the Good News by Being the Good News to each other.
